



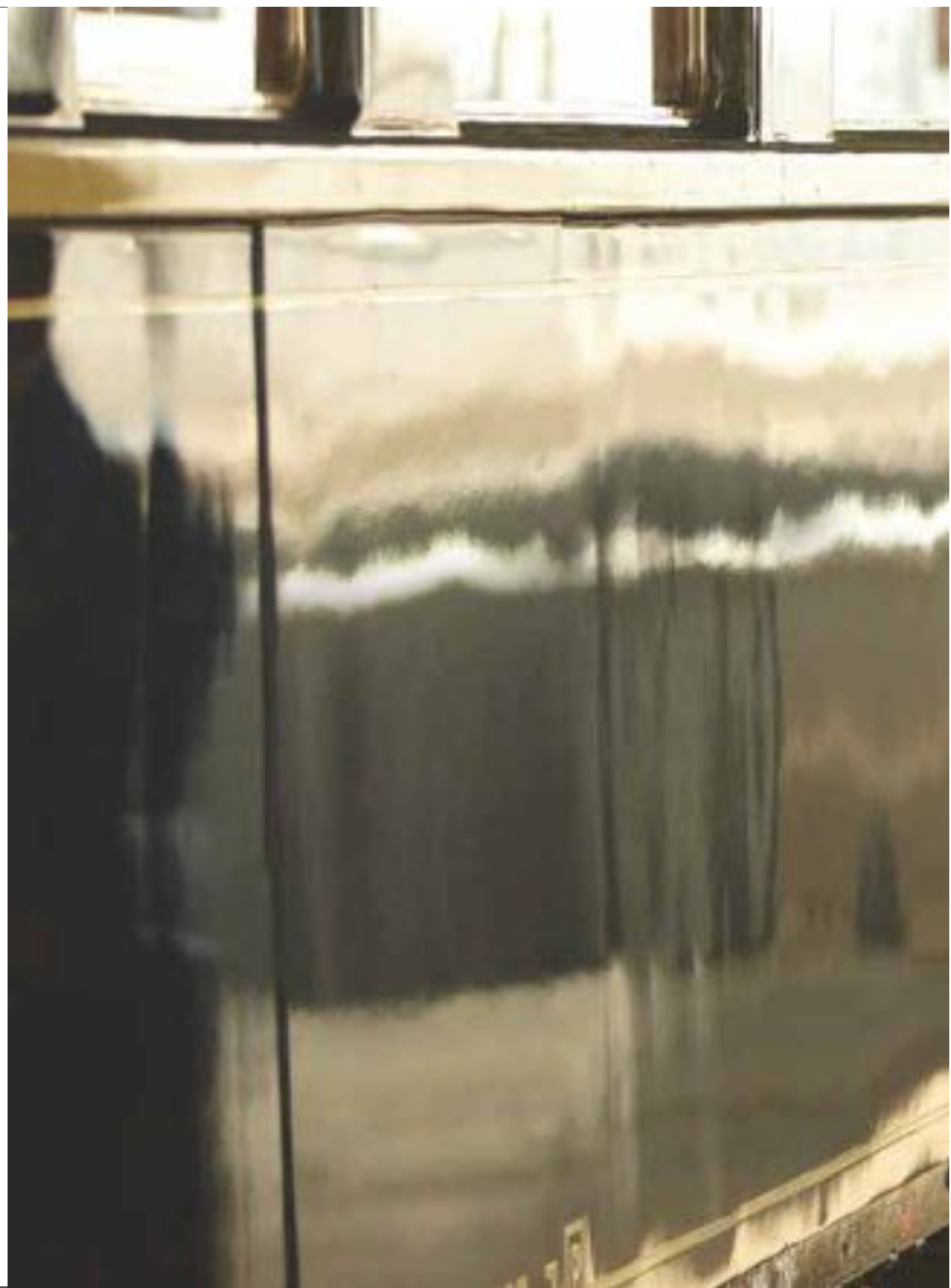

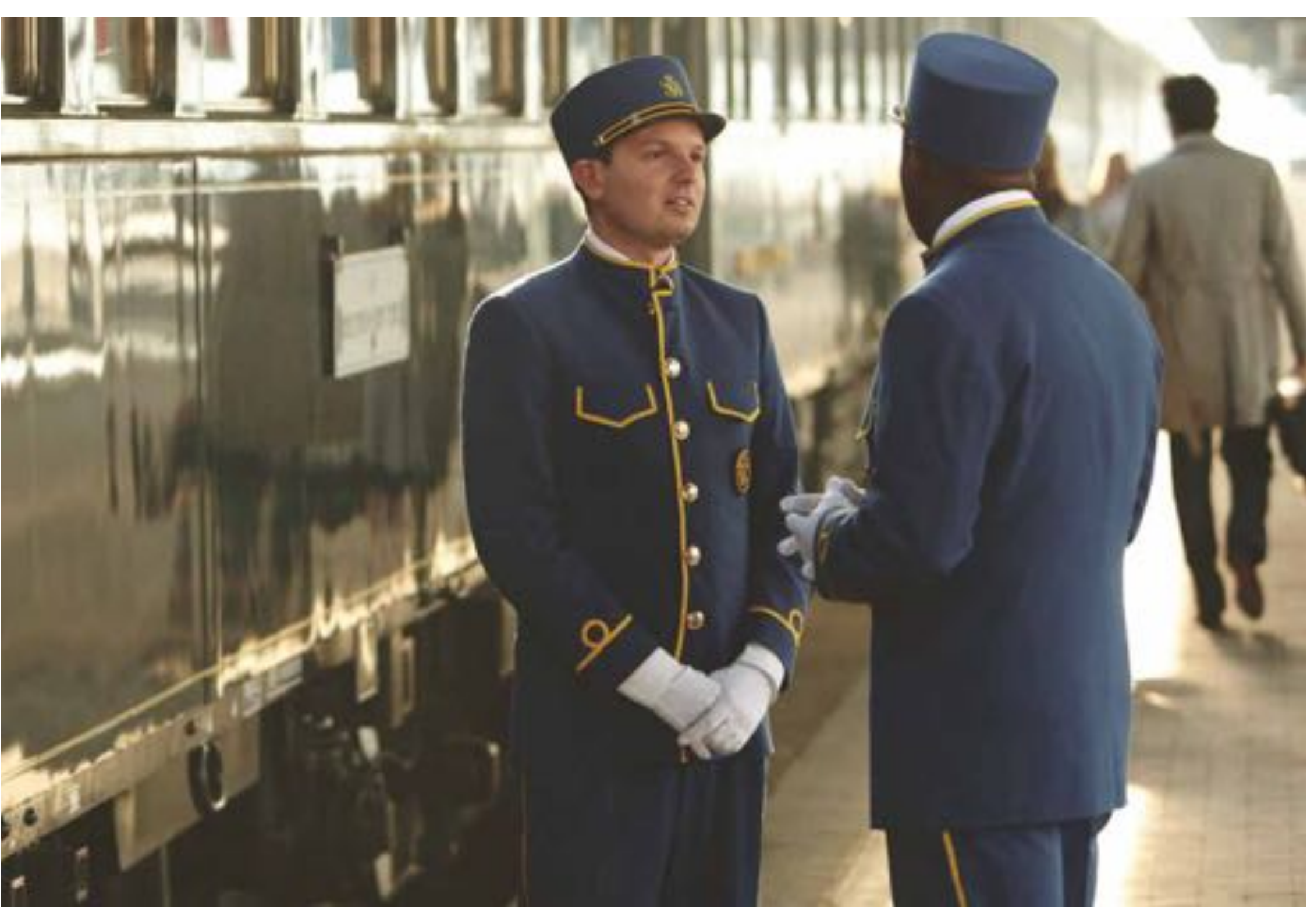

We have two Signature Journeys that take place in June and September of each year: the first travelling to Stockholm from Venice, the second from Paris to Budapest, Bucharest and Istanbul. Our Belmond British Pullman train, which has Day Car seating, will carry you in style between London and the Channel (and vice versa), where you will be escorted by our hosts onto luxury coaches for your 30-minute Eurotunnel shuttle service to Calais, where you will board the Venice Simplon-Orient-Express.

**Train Journey:** this features a trip on board the Venice Simplon-Orient-Express. On some journeys it is possible for you to join the train for different sections of its route.

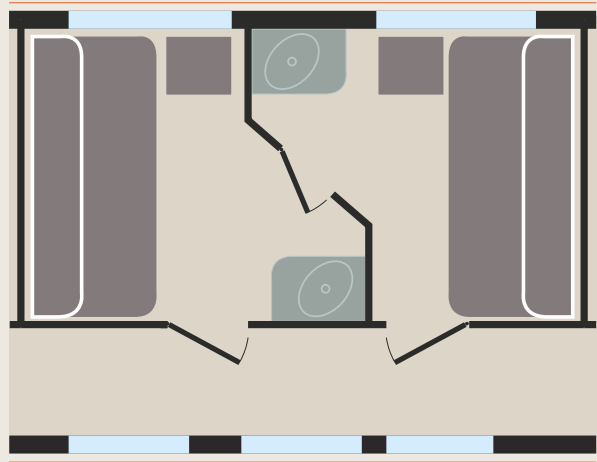

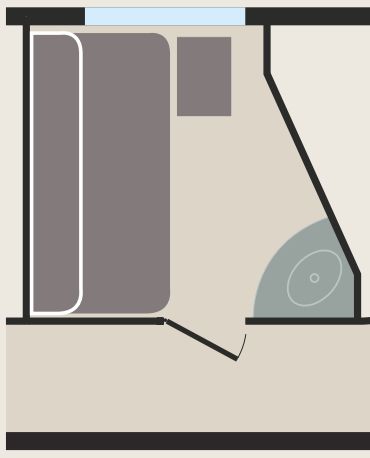

# CITIES TO TAKE YOUR BREATH AWAY

Our train takes you to the most vibrant destinations in Europe, from timeless cities such as Venice and Istanbul to the buzzing capitals of Paris and Stockholm.



## PARIS

Chic, romantic Paris is known as the “city of love”: couples stroll hand in hand along its grand boulevards and ornate bridges; relax in sunny pavement cafés and browse its fragrant flower markets. The French capital is also home to some of the world’s most iconic attractions: the *Mona Lisa*, Notre Dame and the Eiffel Tower, to name a few.

## LONDON

The English capital juxtaposes ancient history with contemporary culture to fascinating effect. At its centre, super-modern skyscrapers such as The Shard sit cheek-by-jowl with historic landmarks like the Tower of London. Immerse yourself in world-famous museums, sizzling West End shows and sensational shops, or simply sit by the Thames and gaze.





### STOCKHOLM

Spread over 14 islands, the historic Swedish capital offers a breath of fresh air—not just for its breezy position but for its forward-thinking attitude. Explore magnificent buildings such as the Royal Palace and City Hall, the fashionable boutiques of Norrmalm or the natural attractions of Djurgården, and discover cool bars on every corner.



### PRAGUE

With its blend of baroque, Renaissance, Art Nouveau and neoclassical architecture, quaint, winding streets bursting with history and star attractions such as the Charles Bridge and Astronomical Clock, the Czech capital's appeal is undeniable. Between sightseeing, make time to sample its delicious independent beers or dine on hearty but refined fare.



### ISTANBUL

Istanbul combines East and West, old and new, like no other city: silks and spices are piled high in the Grand Bazaar as the ululating cry of the muezzin rings out over streets lined with slick bars. Nibble on fragrant Turkish delight while the sun beats down on the Blue Mosque and fishermen cast their lines into the Bosphorus.

### VENICE

Italy's floating city has inspired a thousand poets and artists, from Byron to Canaletto. Just as they were, be inspired by the exceptional delights that await you at every turn, from world-famous sights—the Grand Canal, Rialto Bridges and St Mark's Square with the Basilica—to pretty little canals and charming piazzas.

### VIENNA

Grand palaces and pristine parks characterise the Austrian capital and former seat of the Hapsburg Empire—as do waltzes, opera (Mozart, Beethoven and Strauss are former residents) and coffee houses. Stroll around the hip MuseumsQuartier, browse the boutiques on the Kohlmarkt and sup on schnitzels, strudel and spritzers.

### BUDAPEST

Two vast cities, Buda and Pest, join across the River Danube to form the Hungarian capital. Built on a series of geothermal springs, the city is a renowned spa-lovers' paradise. It is also famed for its café culture: sample a slice of Dobos torte at Café Gerbeaud, the oldest coffee house in the city.

##### **VENICE-PARIS-LONDON**

2 DAYS & 1 NIGHT

**Day 1** Settle into your carriage as the Venice Simplon-Orient-Express crosses the glistening lagoon of Venice. A superb lunch is served in one of the Restaurant Cars. Tea will be served in your cabin before you mingle with fellow passengers in the Bar Car over cocktails expertly created by the Head Barman as you pass by Innsbruck and into the Austrian Alps. Savour a magnificent dinner prepared by our chefs before retiring for the night.

**Day 2** Linger over breakfast in your cabin and watch country turn to city as the train draws into Paris. Enjoy a delicious brunch en route to Calais where we will escort you to your luxury coach transfer. On the other side of the Channel, the Belmond British Pullman train is waiting to take you from Folkestone to London, with afternoon tea served on the way.

##### **LONDON-PARIS-VENICE**

2 DAYS & 1 NIGHT

**Day 1** With champagne in hand, you depart London Victoria aboard the cream and umber train carriages of the Belmond British Pullman. Enjoy brunch as the train wends its way to Folkestone. Join fellow passengers on the luxury coach transfer, taking you across the Channel on the Eurotunnel. Arriving in Calais, relish your first glimpse of the Venice Simplon-Orient-Express' gleaming carriages. Settle into your sumptuous cabin and toast your arrival in the Bar Car before dinner is served in the Restaurant Car.

**Day 2** Wake in the comfort of your cabin and enjoy breakfast with a view. While lunch is served, the train makes its way passed Swiss lakes and through mountain scenery. Relax over afternoon tea before arriving at Venice Santa Lucia Station in the late afternoon.

Arriving in Venice the next day, you are whisked by private boat to beautiful Belmond Hotel Cipriani on Giudecca Island for your stay in a Lagoon View Room with balcony. A private, guided walking tour of Venice and dinner in the hotel's sumptuous Oro Restaurant are both included in your stay. You return home by air. 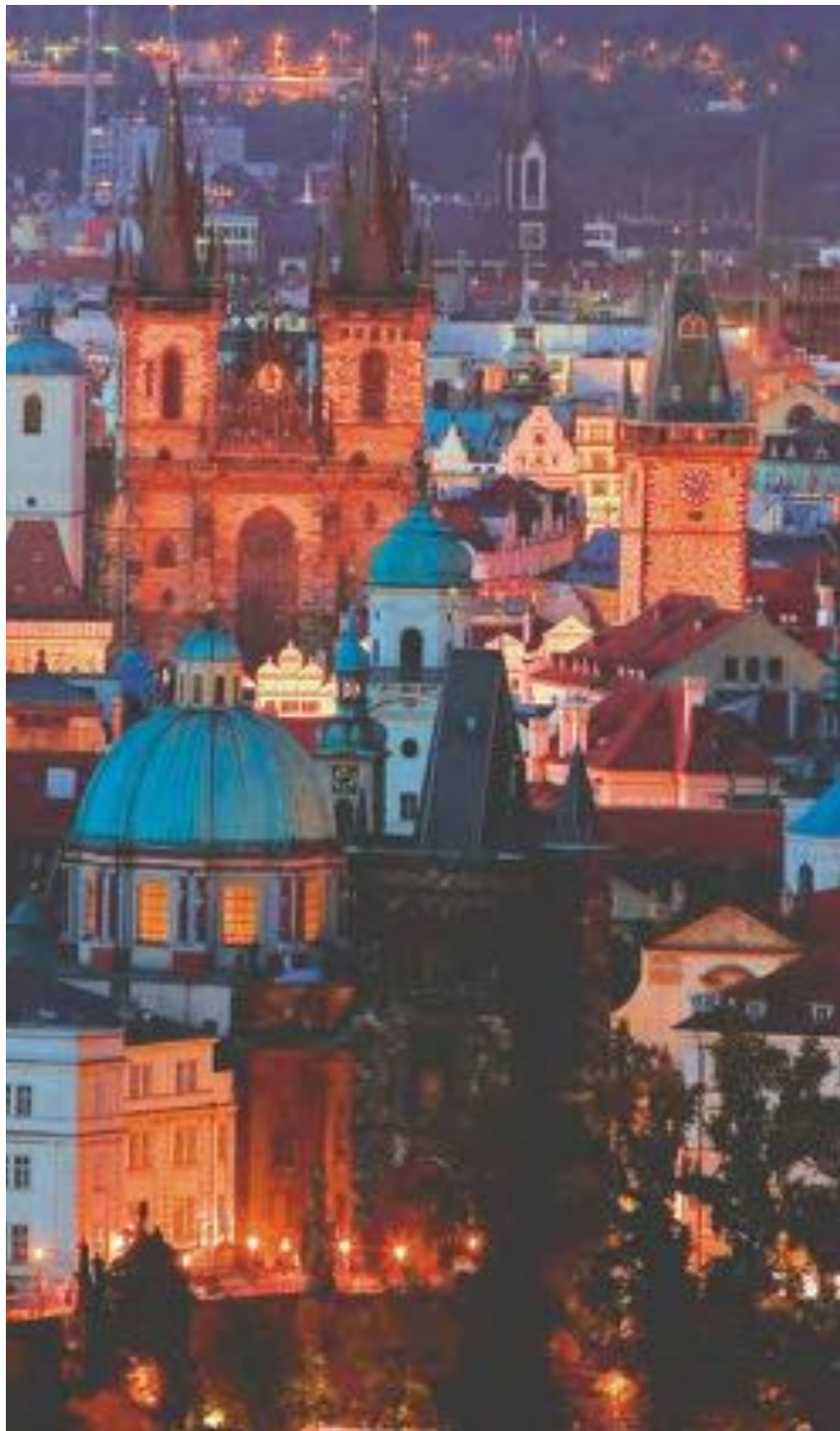

### VENICE-STOCKHOLM
