DAY 1: WELCOME TO VERONA, THE ITALIAN CAPITAL OF FASHION AND SHOPPING

Afternoon

• You will be met at *Venice Marco Polo International Airport* and transferred by Mercedes E-Class to the splendid Villa del Quar in Verona.

Villa del Quar is a luxury hotel with renowned gourmet restaurant at only 5 km from Verona. Villa del Quar was built in Roman times, this National Monument has been a place to stay since 47 A.D.

- Check-in and accommodation in deluxe room.
- Time at disposal for a visit to Verona.

As a setting for Shakespeare's Romeo and Juliet, this city is still a magnet for lovers.

The ancient center of Verona boasts many magnificent Roman ruins, second only to those of Rome itself, and fine palazzo built of rosso di Verona, the local pink-tinged limestone, by the city's medieval rules.

Possibility of visiting the Verona Arena, a Roman amphitheatre built in the first century, still in use today and internationally famous for the large-scale opera performances given there.

DAY 2: PALLADIAN VILLAS AND VALPOLICELLA BY FERRARI

Route: Verona ▶ Vicenza ▶ Valpolicella ▶ Verona

Morning

• Meeting with your Red Travel Tour Director and welcome coffee in the exclusive location of the Villa followed by a dedicated Ferrari briefing, with your car scenically displayed in reserved area.

Our private Tour Director, an expert Ferrari driver, will introduce our guests to the world of Ferrari; clarify the finer details of the controls, explain the differences between the various models (Ferrari F8 Tributo, Ferrari 488 Spider, Ferrari 488 Pista, Ferrari Portofino) and the engine (new 8-cylinder turbo) and most importantly, give guidance on how to handle the F1 paddle-gear shifting behind the steering wheel.

• All luggage will be transported separately.

Departure by Ferrari for the Euganean Hills, to reach Villa Emo Capodilista

Our Tour Director leads you at the wheel of his car, guiding your Ferrari along the splendid scenarios offered by the beautiful Veneto region.

During the whole journey, the Ferrari and the Tour Director's car will be constantly in touch by mobile radio system.

The itinerary drives you towards the Euganean Hills.

• Arrival in Selvazzano Dentro and visit of Villa Emo Capodilista, one of the most beautiful villas built by the famous architect Palladio.

This evocative Venetian Villa was originally built as a hunting lodge in 1568 by the architect and painter Dario Varotari, a student of Veronese. The interior is decorated with frescoes and trompe l'oeil paintings which depict the history of the family, mythological scenes, putti, grottesques and friezes. Surrounded by an Italian-style garden, the Villa opens onto a stunning rural landscape.





Ferrari drive to Soave



Lunch in Soave - Restaurant suggestion: **Enoteca Realda**.

A small, modern restaurant with a wine bar feel. The young staff offer traditional cuisine (such as bigoli pasta with anchovies, capers and dried cherry tomatoes) alongside snacks (ironically referred to as 'fast food') such as hamburgers, piadina flatbreads and club sandwiches.

Afternoon

• Time at disposal for a visit of the village of Soave and its castle.

The Castle of Soave is a typical military artefact of the Medieval age representing one of the best example of castle architecture in Veneto. As a place of great and rare charm, this Castle reveals, with real and tangible testimony, the breath of the past along with the ability to enchant and allure whoever is wishful, in silence, to hear its voice.

The route by Ferrari leads to Valpolicella

- Visit of a wine cellar in Valpolicella, where the famous Amarone DOCG red wine is produced.
- Return to Villa del Quar.

DAY 3: GARDA LAKE BY FERRARI

Route: Verona ▶ Sirmione ▶ Malcesine ▶ Riva del Garda

Morning

Departure by Ferrari for Garda Lake, to reach Sirmione

Arrival in Sirmione and visit of the "Pearl of the lake".

From Catullus to Gonzaga, from Carducci to James Joyce and Maria Callas, many characters have gone from here, taking away a happy memory. Sirmione inspired by the beauty of the place lying in the middle of Lake Garda, the slabs submerged tip of the peninsula, the many romantic spots in the old medieval fishing village; for historical works such as the Roman villa of the Grotte di Catullo, the Scaliger castle, the church of San Pietro in Mavino. The reasons for a visit to Sirmione are many.



Lunch in Sirmione - Restaurant suggestion: La Rucola (1 Michelin star).

Located in in the medieval village of Sirmione, and inside the castle Scala, the restaurant offers quality cuisine and special menus. The restaurant's basic Mediterranean kitchen offers raw materials of excellent quality, wide selection of domestic and foreign wines.

Afternoon

The route by Ferrari leads to the east coast of Garda Lake and then to Riva del Garda

Halt en route in Malcesine.

The route by Ferrari leads to the northernmost part of Garda Lake

Arrival in Riva del Garda and check-in at Lido Palace Garda 5*.

Located on the northern shore of Garda Lake, Lido Palace is an exquisitely restored and redesigned hotel to capture its former glory as a retreat for royalty, a luxury stay in the resort of Riva del Garda, complete with a superb spa and gourmet restaurants.

Route: Riva del Garda ➤ Segonzano ➤ San Cassiano in Badia

Morning

Departure by Ferrari for the Dolomites

• Halt in Segonzano, to discover the splendid phenomenon of the natural earth pyramids that time has created in thousands of years. A natural masterpiece of glacial origin, the Segonzano Pyramids are among the most renowned and studied phenomena in the world.



Lunch in Cavalese - Restaurant suggestion: **El Molin** (1 Michelin star).

Housed in a 17C mill, this restaurant is decorated with a profusion of wood among the old millstones. The skilful, creative cuisine focuses on produce from the surrounding woodland. Traditionalists will enjoy the first-floor wine bar, which offers a limited choice of dishes and local hams.

Afternoon

The route by Ferrari leads to the Val di Fassa and Val di Fiemme

Amazing panoramas of the Dolomites will open before your eyes. The mountain roads you will drive in will be as astonishing as the panoramas you will be able to see on board of your Ferrari

• Arrival in San Cassiano in Badia and check-in at Relais & Châteaux Rosa Alpina 5*.

Route: San Cassiano in Badia ▶ Cortina d'Ampezzo ▶ Valdobbiadene ▶ Venice

Morning

Departure by Ferrari for Cortina d'Ampezzo

Drive on the Dolomites Mountains to reach Villa Abbazia in Follina at the end of the downhill road



Lunch in Follina - Restaurant suggestion: La Corte (1 Michelin star).

Sometimes simplicity can be synonymous with display of extreme richness! At La Corte the common thread is the very concept of "complicated simplicity": preparations are aimed at preserving the genuine flavours of raw materials through careful and continuous research.

Afternoon

The route by Ferrari leads to the Valdobbiadene area

 Visit of a wine cellar in Valdobbiadene, where the famous Valdobbiadene Prosecco DOCG sparkling wine is produced.

Final drive to reach Venice and arrival at Piazzale Roma, arrival point of your Ferrari tour

• Arrival in Venice and transfer by boat to the world's most famous lagoon town.

Accommodation in deluxe room at Hotel Bauer 5* (San Marco).
